

Continues Rain hinders Mantam Bridge restoration

Due to heavy rainfall since last few days at Mantam, the bamboo bridge had been partially damaged by the huge wooden logs carried downstream by high speed water current by Rongyon river. The bamboo bridge could have been erected /repaired by now however due excess rainfall & high speed water current at Mantam lake, the workers are facing difficulties in restoring the work, the SDM Dzongu informed. As such the District Administration to ease the burden has started using the motor boat till further period at Mantam lake. As per direction from the higher authorities the timing of boat service shall be from morning 8 a.m. to 5.30.p.m. beyond the



schedule time the boat shall not be put to service considering upon the bad weather condition and high speed water current at Mantam lake at present.

The labourers engaged in the construction of Foot Suspension Bridge at Mantam stranded at the left bank of Mantam lake since

last two days has been ferried to the right bank of Mantam lake through the rubber boat to expedite the work complete the same at the earliest.
