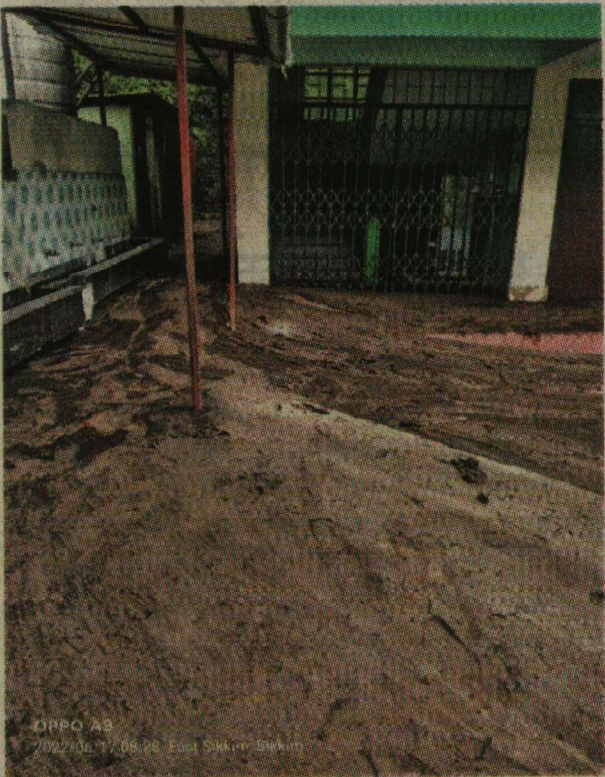


Due to heavy rainfall, cracks have developed on the road connecting Tourism department and Commerce and Industries department. The wall attached to the Tourism department has also been damaged.

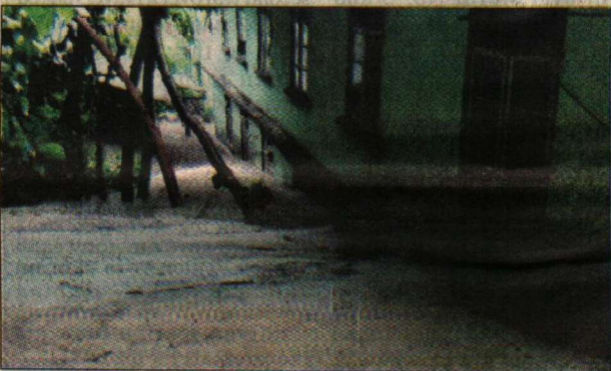
तीन दिनभित्र दोस्रोपटक

रम्फू, १७ जून। पाकिम जिल्लाअन्तर्गत पश्चिम पाण्डाम निर्वाचन क्षेत्रको रम्फू उच्चतर माध्यमिक विद्यालयमा भारी वर्षाको कारण तीन दिनभित्र दोस्रोपटक भल पस्दा विद्यालयको तीनवटा भवन, मिड डे मिलको किचन, सर सामग्री र शौचालयमा धेरै क्षति पुगेको छ। आज बिहान पनि हिलो, माटो सरीको पानी पाठशाला भवनमा पस्दा शिक्षक शिक्षिकाहरूको कागज पत्र, विद्यार्थीहरूको उत्तर पुस्तिका, केही दिन अधिमात्र मर्मत्ती गरिएको किंडरगार्डन क्लासहरू पूर्ण रूपले क्षतिग्रस्त भएको छ। विद्यालयमा भएको क्षतिको आँकलन गर्न रम्फू नगर पञ्चायत अध्यक्ष सञ्जीव कुमार खाती, उपाध्यक्ष श्रीमती राधा प्रधान, विद्यालय प्रबन्धन समितिका अध्यक्ष सीबी गुरुडसहित अन्य सदस्यगण, शिक्षा विभागका सहनिर्देशक केबी छेत्री सहित अन्य अधिकारीहरू पुगेका थिए। यसरी विद्यालय भवनमा क्षति भएको कारण चलिरहेको अर्द्धवार्षिक परीक्षा पनि स्थगित गर्नुपरेको जानकारी प्राप्त भएको छ।

Floodwater enters Rangpo SSS
for second time in three days

RANGPO, June 17: Rangpo Senior Secondary School is likely to postpone half-yearly examinations after floodwater entered the school for the second time in three days, filling classrooms with mud and debris.

The school building, Mid-Day Meal kitchen and lavatories suffered extensive damages. The documents and books were also destroyed.

The school is not sure when it will reopen for classes. The kindergarten class, which was

restored after Tuesday's deluge, has been completely damaged.

According to information, the alleged poor drainage system of Sikkim Cricket Ground located uphill at Mining is the real cause of slush and rainwater entering the school premises.

Similar incident had occurred last year and locals feel the need for a compound wall to save the school.

Area MLA and Sikkim Legislative Assembly Speaker L.B. Das along with officers and Nagar Panchayat had visited the school yesterday.
