

Lastly, I want to extend my sincere thanks to the Government, the higher authorities and the Relief Commissioner for the support extended to us and especially to my team members including ADM/R, SDM/Gangtok, District Project Officer and Training Officer for the hard work they have put in to prepare this booklet.

#### **DISTRICT PROFILE**

#### TOPOGRAPHICAL LOCATION

The East Sikkim is one of the four administrative districts of the Indian state of Sikkim. Geographically, East Sikkim occupies the south-east corner of the state. It is the hub of all administrative activity in the state. It is surrounded by North District in the Northern side and South & West districts in the western side. East Sikkim having Gangtok as its district headquarter is located at topographical location of Latitude - 27° 25' North to 27°11' North and Longitude – 88° 53' East to 88°26' 10" East.

#### AREA & ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISION

East district administers 954 square km of area (95400 Hect). The district is divided into four Sub-Divisions- Gangtok, Pakyong Rongli and Rangpo - which are headed by the respective Sub-Divisional Magistrates and 10 Gram Vikas Kendras headed by respective Gram Vikash Adhikaris. Gangtok, Rangpo and Singtam are major markets in the District. Gram Vikash Kendras comprise of various Gram Panchayat Units (GPUs) each having its own Panchayat Wards at the lowest level. There are fifty two (52) nos. of GPU and two hundreds and ninety (290) nos of villages under East District.

#### **GEOLOGY & GEOMORPHOLOGY**

East district is a part of the Eastern Himalayas and exhibits identical geological features as in other parts of the Eastern Himalayas. Five geological units encountered in the district are Kanchenjunga gneiss, Darjeeling gneiss, Chungthang schists and gneiss, lingtse granite gneiss and daling group of rocks consisting of Phyllite, Slates, Quartzites and Schist of Pre-Cambrian age. Quartenery deposits of alluvium are sporadically developed along the streams and rivers. Due to different sets of structural disturbance numerous fractures, faults, joints, folds etc. have developed in the rocks occuring in the district. Prominent linaments as displayed by geological formation in the area trend along N-S, E-W, NE-SW, ENE-WSW and NW-SE directions.

In the East District out of the total geographic area (964 sq km), 679 sq km of area is covered by forest which is 71.17 percent of the total geographic

area. Very dense forest occupies 162 sq km of the total geographic area, 396 sq km is occupied by the densed forest and 121 sq km is occupied by the open forest. The major physiographic units are hill, valley and slope. The major drainage system in East district are Teesta, Rangpo Chhu and Dik Chhu.

#### MINERAL RESOURCES

Minerals found in the East district include coal, copper, limestone and graphite. Copper deposits are found in East Sikkim. Two deposits, one at Rangpo and the other near Dikchu (north of Gangtok) are being explored. Both are small, multimetal deposits. Sikkim Mining Corporation is working on the copper deposits which envisages mining and milling only. Coal is found at Rangit Rivers. The coal is reportedly non-cooking variety, low in moisture and volatile matter and high in fixed carbon. Crystalline limestone has been reported from Chhangu . Iron occurs chiefly as pyrites in association with chalcopryite. It is most plentiful at Bhotang, where magnetite also occurs. The iron ores have nowhere been put to any economic use. It is abundant in the gneiss and mica schists at places. But it does not appear to be fit for the market.

#### **CLIMATE**

The climate of the district has been roughly divided into the tropical, temperature and alpine zones. For most of the period in a year, the climate is cold and humid as rainfall occurs in each month. The area experiences a heavy rainfall due to its proximity to the Bay of Bengal. The general trend of decrease in temperature with increase in altitude holds good every where. Pre-monsoon rain occurs in April-May and monsoon (south-west) operates normally from the month of May and continues up to early October.

#### **TEMPERATURE**

The mean temperature in the lower altitudinal zone, it varies from 1.5 degree centigrade to 9.5 degree centigrade. Temperature varies with altitude and slope. The maximum temperature is recorded usually during July and August, and minimum during December & January. Fog is a common feature in the entire state from May to September. Biting cold is experienced at high altitude places in the winter months and snowfall is also not uncommon during this period.

#### RIVER SYSTEM.

The Major rivers in the East district are Teesta and Rangit and the minor rivers in the district are Rani Khola, Busuk Khola, Rishi Khola and Ratey Chu. East district is mainly drained by the perennial Tista river with tributaries Dik Chhu, Rate Chhu and Rangpo Chhu. The cultivation is done mainly by springs and surface water from Kholas.

#### INFRASTRUCTURE DETAILS

#### Transportation and communication network

The Sikkim National Transport Bus and other four wheeler taxi serve the means of transport in the east district and connectivity to other district and neighbouring state like West Bengal. Sikkim National Transport buses connect Gangtok to other three districts of Sikkim as well as neighbouring states and there is a transit system and small cab abound.

#### By plane

The nearest airport to East district is Bagdogra (West Bengal). From there one has to hire a taxi to come up to Gangtok. The distance from Bagdogra to Gangtok is 124.5 km and it takes approximately 4 hours to reach Gangtok. Helicopter/ Chopper services are also available from Bagdogra to Gangtok. International Airport construction is underway in Pakyong which is around 32 km from Gangtok. There are two helipad in Ganngtok, one at Burtuk which served for helicopter service and another at Leebing which is basically for Army.

#### By Train

The closest railway station to Gangtok are Siliguri (113 km) and New Jalpaiguri (125 km) connecting Kolkata, Delhi and other important cites of the country. Rail connectivity is under construction between Rangpo in Sikkim to Siliguri in West Bengal.

### By Road

From New Jalpaiguri or from Siliguri station one can hire a taxi or take an auto rickshaw to Siliguri bus stand. From there, one has the option to travel to Gangtok by state bus, roughly a 5-6 hour journey. State bus is operated by Sikkim Nationalized Transport. Bus ride is most comfortable compared to rushing Sumo/Safari/Jeeps. Dozens of jeeps travel to Gangtok daily from Siliguri.

#### **RAINFALL**

An examination of available rainfall data shows that the mean annual rainfall is minimum at Thangu (82 mm.) and maximum at Gangtok (3494 mm.) . An iso9hyatal analysis of these data reveals that there are two maximum rainfall areas (i) South-East quadrant, including including Mangan, Singhik, Dikchu, Gangtok, Rongli etc. (ii) South-West corner including Hilley. Rainfall is heavy and well distributed during the months from May to early October. July is the wettest month in most of the places. The intensity of rainfall during South-West monsoon season decreases from south to North, while the distribution of winter rainfall is in the opposite order. The highest annual rainfall for the individual station may exceed 5000 mm. and average number of rainy days ( days with rain of 2.5 mm. or more) ranges from 100 at Thangu to 184 at Gangtok.

## PROPOSED EVACUATION PLAN FOR GANGTOK CITY

Introduction of Gangtok City

**Gangtok** is the capital of Sikkim State. It also is the headquarters of the East Sikkim. Gangtok is located in the eastern Himalayan range, at an altitude of 1,650 m (5,410 ft). The town's 100286 (as per census 2011) population belongs to different ethnicities such as Indian-Nepalis, Lepchas and Bhutia. Nestled within higher peaks of the Himalaya and enjoying a year-round mild temperate climate, Gangtok is at the centre of Sikkim's tourism industry.

Today, Gangtok City has been divided into fifteen wards or councillors for the easy administrative functions.

## **Response Operation**

- 1. Information of collapse obtained/received from GMC, Govt. or any other source.
- 2. In-charge of control room to rush to site of collapse.
- 3. Control room to inform SP/East (Fire brigade, SDRF, Army, SSRT, DFO(T)), CMO(Ambulance and doctor), In-charge of the temporary assembling points as well as designated areas to activate as per the evacuation plan.
- 4. DPO to intimate Rescue team i.e. Fire brigade, Ambulance, Police, SDRF, SSRT etc. and initiate rescue operation and handed over the charge to designated officer.
- 5. Evacuated victims may be sent to designated assembling point for further arrangement at relief camp or designated areas in co-ordination with ward councillor and CD volunteers.
- 6. Injured victims may be sent to hospital directly via ambulance.
- 7. Subsequently the in-charge of disaster site will inform details of collapse/dead/injured person to the control room for further information to all concern and necessary action to be taken via proper channel.
- 8. All the section head should deploy their officer In-charge in each stage of the situation (disaster site, assembling areas, designated areas, relief materials, requisition of equipments etc) to execute the role /duty perfectly.

#### Role of In-charge of temporary assembling areas

- 1. Clear the area with the help of police and volunteers, arrange traffic if on the road side
- 2. Arrangement of transportation for the victims.
- 3. Co-ordination with nodal officer at the designated areas, disaster site In-charge as well as with control room.

## Role of Nodal Officer at designated areas

- 1. Maintenance of detail number of victims (male/female, children, adult, old or disable person)
- 2. Arrangement of food, water, medicines, blankets etc in co-ordination with section head
- 3. Co-ordination with In-charge temporary assembling point, Section head and control room.
- 4. Requisition of doctors and other emergency items in consultation with Section head.
- 5. Detail report of the victims accommodated to be submitted to control room via section head.




#### INCIDENT COMMAND FLOW CHART

Each ICP is responsible to provide prompt and relevant information to the DEOC concerning any disaster event or potential disaster event occurring within their area. The post is also responsible for the coordination of all local resources as well as those allocated to it for disaster management purposes.


**Incident Commander**: The Incident Commander is responsible for commanding all the activities in case of any incident. The individual designated as the IC has the overall responsibility for all functions. The IC may decide to perform all the coordination, functions himself, or delegate authority to perform functions to other people in the organization. Delegation does not, however, relieve the IC from overall responsibility




**Planning**: The Planning section is responsible for the collection, evaluation, and display of incident information, maintaining status of resource, and preparing the Incident Action Plan and incident related documentations.




**Search & Rescue**: The operations section is responsible for directing the tactical actions to meet the incident objectives within a stipulated time. Tactical action describes what must be accomplished within the selected strategy or strategies in order to achieve the Incident objectives.




**Relief & Rehabilitation**: Coordination of available resources, including those allocated from the state government and disaster area, in support of the disaster affected community. Arrangement of relief camp and later permanent solution for the affected victims.




**Communication:** Communication chief is responsible for collecting the information from the incident area and developing and releasing information about the incident to the news media and to other appropriate agencies and organizations after dully taking approval from IC or the competent authority.



**Transportation:** Transportation chief is responsible for arrangement of transport facilities to the incident area in coordination with branch director. It could be either from road, Air or other means.



**Logistics**: The Logistics Section is responsible for providing adequate services and support to meet all incident or event needs. Apart from support & Service branches, Finance is also a branch in Logistics. The Finance Branch is responsible for keeping track of incident-related costs, personnel and equipment records, and administering procurement contracts associated with the incident or event.
